



- 6. Valley fold.
- 7. Squash point while twisting clockwise.




9. Valley fold and unfold. Repeat on other three sides.




8. Valley fold to center.


10. Valley fold while lifting corner up. Mountain fold edge along diagonal center crease.




11. Open and squash.




14. Flip the model over.




17. Mountain fold to lock in place. Then repeat steps16 - 17 on opposite side.




12. Repeat steps 10 - 11 on other three sides. Then, rotate model 45 degrees.




15. Pinch to reinforce valley fold creases and raise mountain folds from center.




18. Flip the model over.




13. Valley fold and unfold. Repeat on other three sides.



16. Shift the pleat by valley folding (along existing crease) and tucking edge into crevice (circled point to circle point).



19. Shift the pleat by mountain folding (along existing crease) and pulling across the layer underneath.



20. Flip the model over. Some shaping of the layers may be necessary for the model to hold its overall shape.
